PRODUCTION PHASE	MOVEMENT PHASE	BUILDING PHASE	WONDER PHASE
<p>1) Primary Producers produce goods</p> <p>2) Players <i>may</i> determine player order</p> <p>3) On your turn, in each area you have a transporter, you may perform the following actions in any order and as often as desired:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Load or unload goods, or load transporters b) Turn in goods to produce goods from Secondary Producers c) Perform research (each transporter factory may be upgraded now if a transporter is in the hex) <p>X) Donkeys (if you allow them) and geese reproduce if alone as a pair in a hex</p> <p>Y) Secondary producers and research consume unclaimed goods and produce output; research is wasted</p>	<p>1) Players <i>may</i> determine player order</p> <p>2) On your turn, you may perform the following actions (as desired) <u>in this order</u>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Unload carried transporters b) Load or unload goods; or load transporters c) Move each transporter (each may load or unload goods and transporters during movement, and may be followed by geese) d) Load or unload goods; or load transporters 	<p>1) Players <i>may</i> determine player order</p> <p>2) On your turn, in each area you have a transporter, you may perform the following actions in any order and as often as desired:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Load or unload goods; or load transporters b) Build a building c) Build a road or bridge d) Build a new mine shaft (research required) e) Build, strengthen or demolish a wall (replace demolished walls with neutral walls) 	<p>1) Players <i>may</i> determine player order</p> <p>2) On your turn, if you have a transporter in your home hex, you may build bricks using goods from that hex</p> <p>3) A neutral brick is placed on the Wonder</p> <p>4) The game ends immediately when a brick is placed on the last Wonder space, or the last neutral brick is placed on the Wonder</p>
DETERMINING PLAYER ORDER			
	<p>1) Starting with the player closest to the temple, each player has the option of moving his praying token to the back of the temple row.</p>	<p>Players cannot move their piece further back than the previous player moved.</p>	<p>2) In order from left to right on the temple track, each player then chooses a playing position for his numbered token on the turn-order track.</p>
